Kelsey, President of our society, and former minister at the Old South Union Church in South Weymouth, has taken the pastorate at the Congregational Church at Plainville, Connecticut. Mr. Kelsey was most active in promoting the reorganization of the Society, and was particularly interested in the development of Society-sponsored educational programs for the youth of Weymouth.
