BY-LAWS CHANGE: According to the By-Laws of the Weymouth Historical Society, the Executive Board consists only of its four officers and the curator. Most organizations of this size have an Executive Board or a Board of Directors to assist the officers in their decisions, feeling that more persons should be involved in the work of the Society. The following resolution is submitted to be voted on at the Annual Meeting in April:

Add to Article IV of the Constitution:

"A Board of Directors consisting of six persons shall assist the officers in the business of the Society. They shall be elected by ballot at the Annual Meeting for a term of three years, two to be elected each year."

Change Section 2 of the By-Laws to read:

"The Executive Committee shall consist of all elected officers and elected directors and the Curator of the Society."
